- Title I programs are federally funded.
- Intent and Purpose
 - Support students that are achieving below benchmark
- Schoolwide vs. Targeted
 - Ugly is a schoolwide Title 1 building which means that we service students K-8.
- Title Fund Allocation

 - Intervention Materials and Programs
 - Professional Development for paraprofessionals and teachers
- Title Programming supports our School Improvement Plan in our efforts to have students be proficient in reading and math.

Student Assessments

- Benchmark Assessments
 - Administered to all students 3 times per year (Fall, Winter, & Spring)
 - Measures
 - Acadience (Formerly known as DIBELS)
 - STAR
 - Early Literacy (K-1st)
 - Reading (2nd-5th)
 - Math (1st-5th)
- Interventions and Progress Monitoring
 - Students scoring below benchmarks are then progress monitored once every 3 weeks using the measures listed above.

Communication

- Weekly newsletter from classroom teacher
- Monthly newsletter from principal
- Progress monitoring reports
- Students receiving intervention support for scoring below benchmark will be progress monitored every 3 weeks.
- Progress monitoring reports will be sent home with student's updated scores.

- Ugly School Compact

- Parents Right to Know
 - The right to know if your child is receiving Title I services. All students that score below benchmark on the benchmark assessments will receive a letter home that they will receive interventions and support from our Title I program services.
 - The right to know your student's teacher or paraprofessionals training and credentials available upon request.

Parent's Rights Continued

- Staff qualifications
 - Teacher
 - Degree in Education
 - Valid teaching certificate
- Paraprofessional
 - At least two years of study at an institution of higher education (minimum of 48 credit hours)
 - Obtain an associate's degree or higher
 - High School diploma and passing score on ETS Parapro Assessment
- Parents will be notified if their child's teacher does not meet the qualifications listed above.

Michigan's Third Grade Reading Law

- Your child's reading progress will be closely monitored beginning in kindergarten. If your child is not reading where expected, a plan to improve reading will be created. This means your child's teacher and school will work with your child to find where your child needs support in his/her reading development and create a plan to support him or her.
 - This plan which is called an IRIP (individualized reading intervention plan) includes
 - Extra instruction or support in areas of need.
 - Ongoing checks on reading progress
 - A Read-at-Home plan that encourages you and your child to read and write outside of the school day.
