# Marking Period 1

## Reading

- -Writes name correctly
- -Can isolate and blend sounds together in words
- -Produces rhyming words
- -Identifies sounds

#### Math

- -Identifies and writes numbers to 10
- -Counts to 20

## Behavior Expectations

- -Follows directions
- -Stays in seat
- -Raises hand to speak

# Marking Period 3

## Reading

-Reads and writes simple sentences using CVC words and "Tricky Words"

## Math

-Completes simple addition and subtraction independently

## Behavior Expectations

-Completes and returns homework

# Marking Period 2

### Reading

- -Identifies all letter sounds
- -Reads and writes CVC words (ex: cat)
- -Can blend, segment, and manipulate sounds in words

#### Math

- -Identifies and writes numbers to 31
- -Counts to 100

## Behavior Expectations

-Works well independently and in groups

# Marking Period 4

## Reading

- -Independently reads from Skills Reader
- -Independently writes 1-2 sentences

## Math

- -Can fluently add and subtract numbers 0-5
- -Identifies and uses numbers to 100

## Behavior Expectations

- -Shows responsibility
- Progress monitoring will take place each month. If a student is struggling to meet these academic and behavior expectations, students will receive additional support through the Title I program. Parents will receive monthly progress reports on student growth. The expectation for the end of kindergarten is mastery of all skills.
